#### Softball


Team earned the 6th seed in playoffs this year, they will be traveling to Cassadaga Valley on Thursday for the quarter finals.

### NEWEST ADDITIONS TO THE PATHWAYS

- A student with a disability may appeal [Regents] scores between 52 and 54 on up to two Regents examinations in any discipline and graduate with a local diploma.
- In the event a student with a disability is unable to attain a passing score on science/social studies Regents, upon parent written request, the student may seek a Superintendent's Determination of a local diploma.
