MATH UPDATE - Students are doing well on the math fact challenge. Some have passed their 2's and are on to their 10's already! We do the tens next because they are simple, Just Add O!. Students are learning the concept of both multiplication and division simultaneously because they are inverse operations. The answer in division is just an unknown factor. We are also learning that each number in a number sentence REPRESENTS something from a drawing or word problem (the total, the size of the group, or the # of groups). We are also learning to use the Read, Draw, Write (RDW) process to help us with our problem solving. Remember to visit my webpage for several useful website links for math and spelling!

ELA UPDATE- Our main texts this week were Rain School and Nasreen's Secret School. We learned about how children in Chad have to build their own schools from scratch every year.
