

## Allegany - Limestone Student Driving/Parking Privileges

Driving and parking on campus are privileges, not rights. Please keep in mind that failure to abide by ALHS Driving/Parking Rules or the ALCS Code of Conduct may lead to a revocation of these privileges.

- 1.) Every vehicle (including second vehicles, rentals and replacements) must be registered with the High School Office; those that aren't will be **towed at the owner's expense**. The assigned parking tag should be affixed to the **bottom driver's side corner of the front windshield** of the vehicle you registered. If you are driving an alternate vehicle for only a day or two, please notify the High School Office to avoid incurring a minor infraction removal (Green/Red) to the outer lot. Please report any change of vehicle to the High School Office **before** moving the tag.
- 2.) Student drivers are expected to abide by correct driving procedures, such as: speed limits, stop signs, and rights of way. Signs have been posted on campus for safety reasons.
- 3.) Student drivers are expected to park squarely in the marked spaces, and in the areas of the lot that are numbered for students - **see the map on the opposite side of this sheet**.
- 4.) Please report the make, model and license plate number of any vehicle that's being driven or parked inappropriately on campus to the High School Office.
- 5.) The **Infraction Schedule** is for minor offenses only. Any incident that endangers the safety of others may result in the immediate and total loss of privileges to drive/park on school property.

### Infraction Schedule

- 1<sup>st</sup> Offense (Green) - removal to roadside parking lot for up to 5 weeks.
  - 2<sup>nd</sup> Offense (Red) - removal to roadside parking lot for up to 10 weeks.
  - 3<sup>rd</sup> Offense - loss of privileges to drive/park on school property.
- 6.) Drivers may enter the building through the **Gator Lobby (G doors) from 7:00 - 7:45 a.m. only. The High School Lobby (B doors) must be used from 7:45 - 2:53**. The security of the building necessitates this rule.
  - 7.) During the school day, students may access their vehicles and return to the building only in emergency situations and when accompanied by a staff escort.
  - 8.) Students who experience excessive tardiness and absenteeism from class will have their driving/parking privileges revoked in the best interest of their education.
  - 9.) Students attending local colleges must complete additional paperwork in the High School Office before being permitted to drive.
